Në zbatim të ligjit nr. 80, datë 22.07.2015 "Për arsimin e lartë dhe kërkimin shkencor në institucionet e arsimit të lartë në Republikën e Shqipërisë", ligjit nr. 109/2024 "Për shkencën dhe kërkimin shkencor në Republikën e Shqipërisë", ligjit Nr. 8480, datë 27.05.1999 "Për funksionimin e organeve kolegjiale të administratës shtetërore dhe enteve publike", VKM nr. 464, datë 31.07.2025 "Për disa ndryshime dhe shtesa në vendimin nr. 607, datë 31.8.2016, të Këshillit të Ministrave "Për krijimin, përbërjen, organizimin dhe funksionimin e Agjencisë Kombëtare të Kërkimit Shkencor dhe Inovacionit (AKKSHI), Protokollit për Bashkëpunim në Shkencë dhe Teknologji midis Këshillit të Kërkimit Shkencor dhe Teknologjik të Turqisë dhe Ministrisë së Arsimit dhe Shkencës së Republikës së Shqipërisë, i cili u nënshkrua në Ankara më 6 prill 2010, me kërkesë të Agjencisë Kombëtare të Kërkimit Shkencor dhe Inovacionit, Bordi i Administrimit të AKKSHI në mbledhjen e datës 18.06.2026,

VENDOSI:

1. Miratimin e Draft Memorandumit të Mirëkuptimit mbi Bashkëpunimin në Shkencë dhe Teknologji ndërmjet Ministrisë së Industrisë dhe Teknologjisë së Republikës së Turqisë dhe Ministrisë së Arsimit në Shqipëri (dokumentacioni bashkëlidhur këtij vendimi);
2. Vijimin e procedurave të nënshkrimit të Memorandumit të Mirëkuptimit në nivel ndër-institucional;
3. Ngarkohet AKKSHI për zbatimin e këtij vendimi.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
on Cooperation in Science and Technology
between
The Ministry of Industry and Technology of the Republic of Türkiye
and
The Ministry of Education of the Republic of Albania

The Ministry of Industry and Technology of the Republic of Türkiye and the Ministry of Education the Republic of Albania (hereinafter referred to individually as the "Participant" and collectively as the "Participants"),

Considering the Protocol on Cooperation in Science and Technology between the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Türkiye and the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Albania that was signed in Ankara on 6 April 2010,

Recognising the importance of science, technology and innovation in the development of their national economies,

Wishing to strengthen and develop scientific and technological cooperation on the basis of equality and mutual benefit, have decided as follows:

Paragraph 1

The Participants will encourage and support cooperation in the field of science and technology between research entities, universities and research institutes of the Republic of Türkiye and the Republic of Albania according to the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and the existing legislation and regulations of each country.



Paragraph 2 Competent Authorities

The competent authorities responsible for the implementation of this MoU will be the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Türkiye (TÜBİTAK) and the National Agency for Scientific Research and Innovation of Albania (NASRI/AKKSHI).

The competent authorities will sign an additional agreement for the implementation of this MoU. The said agreement will include the required details about the financial terms and conditions, intellectual property rights, utilisation of the output of cooperative activities, as well as the other relevant issues.

Paragraph 3 Forms of Cooperation

Cooperative activities, which within the framework of this MoU may be undertaken in the following forms:

- a) Exploring the possibilities on joint research, development and innovation projects;
- b) Exchange of individual scientists for the purpose of conducting academic research work;
- c) Organising and participating in joint academic scientific and technological events;
- d) Exchange of information on the management of technoparks, conduct activities about Joint Centers of Excellence and Joint Laboratories including cooperation with industry, technology transfer offices and innovation ecosystems;
- e) Participation in European Union Framework Programmes (EU FPs) for research, development and innovation;
- f) Capacity building activities, including training of early-career researchers and institutional strengthening.

Paragraph 4 Costs

This MoU does not create any financial obligations on the Participants. Each Participant will bear all its own expenses arising from the implementation of this MoU, including the expenses related to traveling and participation in seminars and

workshops, unless otherwise decided by mutual consent, according to its ordinary budget availability and without any additional cost for their respective budget.

**Paragraph 5
Dissemination of Resulting Information**

Scientific and technological results and any other information derived from the cooperation activities under this MoU will be shared, announced, published or commercially exploited with the written consent of both project partners and according to the international agreements concerning intellectual property rights to which states of the both Participants are participants.

**Paragraph 6
Implementation and Legal Aspects**

- a) This MoU is concluded with a view to enhancing and developing cooperation between the Participants and does not constitute an agreement binding upon the States of the Participants under international law. No provision of this MoU will be interpreted and implemented as creating legal rights or commitments for the States of the Participants.
- b) This Protocol will not affect the validity or execution of any obligation arising from other international treaties or agreements concluded by the States of the Participants.
- c) Any disputes related to the interpretation or implementation of this MoU will be settled through consultations between the Participants.
- d) This MoU may be amended or supplemented at any time through mutual written consent of the Participants.

**Paragraph 7
Initiation and Termination**

- a) This MoU will enter into force on the date when it is signed by both Participants.
- b) This MoU will remain in force for a period of five (5) years and will automatically be renewed for further periods of five (5) years, unless either Participant notifies in writing its intentions to terminate this MoU.

c) Each Participant may terminate this MoU at any time by giving to other Participant a written notification to that effect. In this case, the termination will come into effect in six (6) months from the receiving date of the written notification. The termination of this MoU will not affect the projects or programmes undertaken under this MoU and not fully executed at the time of the termination of this MoU.

d) With the entry into force of this Memorandum of Understanding, the "Protocol of Cooperation between the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Albania and the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey (TÜBİTAK)", signed in Ankara on 6.4.2010, is repealed.
